

Call for Recommendations: Spring 2026

Graduate School Special Scholarship for Natural Sciences and Engineering Majors

1. Scholarship Amount: 75% of Tuition (including Admission Fee)

- * TQ2: 1st~2nd semester full tuition, 3rd~4th semester half tuition (including admission fee)
- TQ3: 1st~3rd semester full tuition, 4th~6th semester half tuition (including admission fee),
- * The scholarship recipient must directly pay the remaining amount (excluding the 75% portion covered by the scholarship) of their tuition during the official registration period.

2. Requirements

- ① A faculty member (including adjunct faculty) may only recommend an applicant applying to their department.
- ② The faculty recommender must describe their recruitment activities or other efforts made to attract the applicant to apply to Ewha.
- ③ The faculty recommender must provide support for the applicant's living expenses.
- ④ The applicant must meet one of the following requirements:
 - i. Korean proficiency: TOPIK level 4 or above
 - ii. English proficiency: TOEFL iBT 80, IELTS 6.0, New TEPS 326 or above
 - iii. Completion of university education conducted entirely in English (Only when English is her first language)
- ⑤ Admitted applicants must meet with their faculty recommender every semester and submit a study plan* by the beginning of each semester. The study plan must be filled out and signed by both the student and sponsoring faculty and submitted in person to the International Student Affairs Team (ECC B329).

- ※ Please be careful in submitting recommendation letters; should there be any type of withdrawal after the student has been selected as a scholarship recipient, the authority of the relevant faculty member to recommend Graduate School Special Scholarship candidates may be restricted to a certain extent in the future.
